

Volunteer Positions

- **Promoters**

- Unequivocally, promoters are one of the most important positions as they are responsible for promoting the word of Yes! on Equality. Promoter positions include:
 - Social Networking Messengers (spreading news on Facebook, Myspace, Twitter..)
 - In-person Canvassers - going person-to-person or posting fliers
 - Diversity Coordinators – reach out to minority organizations, such as Hispanic, Black, Asian and Women chamber of commerces, NAACP, and the like
 - Booths – similar to in-person canvassers by helping to spread awareness. Locations include farmers’ markets, colleges, and local events

- **Media Volunteers**

- An essential element to the Yes! Campaign are media volunteers as they are truly the voice of this campaign. Positions are writing intensive and include:
 - Press writers – establish press releases as needed
 - Bloggers – reach out by writing to the community
 - Website gurus – write content for those who will be visiting the Yes! on Equality website.

- **Event Organizers**

- This position works closely with our Diversity Coordinators and Canvassers. Event Organizers are responsible for attending, organizing and setting up relevant LGBT events and booths.
